Crew Cab Tool & Equipment Checklist

Crew Cab must have the following tools on board:

4—Lock out Locks	1—Track Level	1—Four Way
2—Derails	4—Track Jacks	1—Rail Puller
2—Claw Bars	The following Wrench	4—Shovels
2—Line Bars	Sizes:	4—Flat Shovels
4—Spike Mauls	1-1/2", 1-11/16", 1-7/8",	1—Gauge Spreader
1—Grease Gun	2-1/16", 2-1/4"	1—Switch Broom
1—Spike Lifter	1—Switch Wrench	1—Rail Saw
1—Fuel Container	2—Tie Tongs	1—Rail Drill

The following items need to remain fully stocked on board the crew cab:

2—Saw Blades	1—Keg of Assorted Bolts	1—Tube of Grease
2—Drill Bits	1—Bundle of Tie Plugs	2—Hammer Handles
1—Keg of Spikes	2—Containers of 2-Stroke Oil	

It is the responsibility of the employee parking the truck at the end of the work day to fully restock the crew cab. Tools may be borrowed from the Shop but only after being checked out on the Tool Sign Out Sheet. Tools may also be borrowed from other crews but must be replaced onto the proper vehicle at the end of the project. If a crew cab is found to be incorrectly stocked and equipped, both the foreman and the driver will be subject to On Track's Disciplinary Policy. Please remember, this new procedure is not meant to be a nuisance, it is simply necessary in order to ensure each crew is efficiently equipped with the tools needed in order to make each employee's work easier to accomplish.
